Thank you for inquiring about the RV Training Center course for the training and certification of RV technicians. The State of Florida Department of Education approved RVTC school catalogue and accompanying "info packet" should answer any questions you may have.

Our instructors have many years of RV repair experience in the field as well as being RV Master Certified by RVDA/RVIA and RVTC. Recreational Vehicle Training Center will certify you as an RV Technician upon graduation.

What should you look for when choosing a school for top notch RV training? - A school that teaches nothing else! Our RV program is condensed into just 10 weeks. We offer over 50% hands-on-training plus onsite training on most types of RVs (Class A, Class C, Fifth-Wheels, Travel Trailers, etc.).

Some of our RV technician graduates will go to work for dealers after they graduate for job benefits (insurance, vacation, etc.) and security. Some of our graduates will go into business for themselves and do quite well. A few will already be retired and will only work a few hours a week on RVs, but they will make more than enough money to pay for their living expenses possibly without touching their retirement.

Our classes are filled on a "first come, first served" basis. When you decide which class you would like to attend, we will need four items from you to reserve your seat in that class:

1. A completed "Student Information Sheet".*
2. A completed "Student Information Section" on the front of the "Student Enrollment Agreement".*
3. Send a check for the \$ 100 application fee made out to "RV Training Center"
4. Bring a copy of your high school diploma or G.E.D. (required by the State of Florida).

Finally, if you plan to attend our "winter" class which begins in January, please be aware that January is the middle of the tourist season in Florida and many campgrounds are "totally booked" at that time. Reservations should be made two to four months in advance to reserve a good spot for our 10-week course.
